The “Projektverbund Bleiberecht” supports refugees who are entitled to stay in Germany

To further secure and retain this entitlement, refugees are required to submit proof of having a job or being on a training program.

Asylum-seekers and people carrying the status of “Duldung” could also increase their chances of gaining legal residence on proof of having means of earning sufficient income.

For whom is the project designed?

This project is meant for you if:

- » **You are** a refugee entitled to stay according to §104 a/b and §23 (1) of the aliens act
- » **You are** carrying the status of “Duldung” and with working permit
- » **You are** an asylum-seeker now holding the “Aufenthaltsgestattung” for at least a year
- » **You are** a refugee whose status falls under the category of “all others”
- » **You are** seeking a job or training opportunity
- » **You** fear losing your job

We care for the clarification of your resident status and related work permit issues

We assist you in your search for job or suitable training program

We establish contacts with various firms and other relevant employers for jobs on your behalf

We support you in other job-seeking matters:

writing of application letters, C.V. and other materials

We offer special German language and computer courses and up-grade your professional qualifications

We accompany and support you retain and secure your job and train you to broaden your access to the job market
